## **Critical to Know**

- More than 600,000 cases of child abuse are reported in the U.S. each year
- CACs educate more than 1.5 million people annually
- Nearly two-thirds of cases handled by CACs involve child sexual abuse
- Exposure and consumption of pornography are common reports of victims interviewed at CACs
- The average age kids are exposed to violent pornography is 12
- Viewing porn can lead to sexual misconduct, abuse of children, grooming, and sextortion
